About the Education

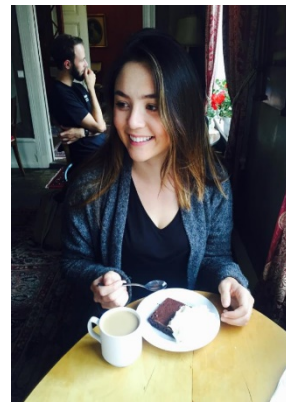
